### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:**

- A. High School graduates shall be enrolling in an Accredited College or University located within the United States of America by Fall of the same year.
- B. Student Applicant must be a direct descendant (child or a grandchild) of a current Regular Member of the Filipino-American Association as defined in Section 5.05a of the Constitution and By-Laws.

### **CRITERIA:**

**Complete this Application and submit with a copy of the following Documents:**

- A. Official High School transcript (Minimum GPA 3.0)
- B. No more than 2 pages listing Academic and Non-Academic Honors and Awards, Achievements, Certifications, etc.
- C. No more than 2 listing Community Service/Volunteer Work (civic, religious, social, etc.); Extra-Curricular Activities (sports, drama, music, etc.); or any Work Experience obtained while attending High School.
- D. Original Essay (250 words minimum in 12-point Arial font): *"As a Filipino youth, the values, customs and traditions I learned that will help me in my college life"* and *"How do I envision my college degree to make a difference in my Community"*. Include Your Career Goals, How You Overcome Life's Challenges and Your Hopes and Dreams for the Future.

### **EVALUATION PROCESS:**

The Filipino-American Association Scholarship Committee will review and rate each Criteria Category (A, B, C & D) with a maximum score of 25 points for a total of 100 points. Applicant with the highest Averaged Percentage Score is the Recipient.
